Monday thru Friday, supper is provided by the community. Sometimes it is churches, other times it's community groups. Tonight it was the Morgantown Board of Realtors. We were told that last night, WVU Coach Bob Huggins and his wife paid for the evening meal.

We were told that at Christmas all families were given a hand made quilt. As they were holding their quilts for a photo, they were [each] handed a \$500 gift card from an anonymous donor. What a blessing this must have been for those families.
