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
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Sleep Well, Heal Well; New Beds For Comfortable Healing

Rosenbaum Family House welcomes over 1,700 families each year, providing a peaceful refuge from the pressures they face while dealing with medical issues. We are full every night of the year, with many guests staying with us for over a week. This causes a lot of wear and tear on our facilities, affecting our ability to provide a restful environment that promotes healing.

Through the "Sleep Well, Heal Well" initiative, we aim to replace all of our existing beds with new beds that are both more comfortable and more durable for long-term use. The cost per bed is \$2,000. Your gift to sponsor a bed will ensure that we offer our guests maximum comfort, so they find respite from the challenges associated with their care.
